2. Institute will make available final year students for an internship.


3. Institute will assign students according to the activities/task given

11. Certificate for internship will be given jointly by IMCC collage and PEF.

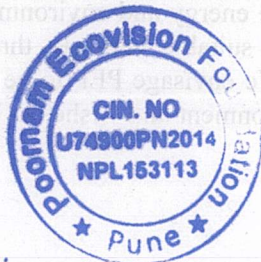
Role of PEF

The duration of the MoU is from April 2022 to March 2024

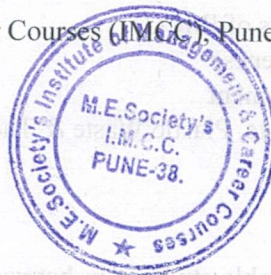
