CLAUSE 1: CO-OPERATION

CLAUSE 2: SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 Guest Lectures: Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.2 Placement of trained students: second party will actively engage to help the delivery of the training and placement of the students of the first party on the technology trends and in house requirements.
- 2.3 There is no financial commitment on the part of the MES's Institute of Management and Career Courses, the first party to take up any program mention in MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.
- 2.5 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required.

CLAUSE 3: VALIDITY

3.1 This Agreement will be valid **till 8th June 2025 or** until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Part.
