

## KRC Activities: -

### User Orientation Program

Every year, MES IMCC's KRC conducts an orientation program for aspirants of MBA and MCA to make them aware of the KRC features. 



### Outreach Programs:

Autonomous programs of Library and Information Science by the MES, Pune India

#### Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN)

The Maharashtra Education Society launched a one-year autonomous program -Postgraduate Diploma in Digital Library Management Automation and Networking (PGDLIMAN) for Indian library science professionals to get the latest practical knowledge of ICT applications in the libraries and information centers. This program is a boon to the qualified LIS professionals working in the colleges and academic institutions in the state for effectively applying the ICT in the libraries and Information centers. the 3rd batch of PGDLIMAN - Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (One Year Autonomous Program of MES Pune) is successfully conducted at MES IMCC Pune India.

The candidates of the 3rd batch of PGDLIMAN (2024) completed the one-year program; the candidates registered from Pune, Mumbai, Amravati, Ahmednagar, Satara. The program uses hybrid media for the session conduction, assignment evaluation, and examination conduction. The primary medium is Google classroom followed by zoom and offline sessions.

The learners were doctorates of LIS and qualified working Librarians from the Maharashtra state - including Amravati, Nanded, Ahmednagar, Mumbai, Satara, and Pune, registered for PGDLIMAN MES's IMCC a Post Graduate Diploma Program (Autonomous) involving 15 courses; the program conducted in a hybrid mode with a focus on Google Classroom and the need-based offline sessions including the theory and practical work and case studies in knowledge resource centers in the nation. A continuous assessment involving the assignments and the presentations with a term-end examination.

The program is based on the objective of imbibing technological and management skills among budding qualified Librarians in society to develop them as an independent library manager who will manage the libraries in the new era successfully.

It is certainly the success of collaborative efforts done by the LIS faculty - Jay Bhatt, University Librarian - engineering Drexel University USA, Prof (Dr) S K Patil Former UL SPPU & Dr. Dahibhate, Prof (Dr.) Mrs. Meenal Oak as well as the CS faculty - Dr Narasingoju, Dr Kulkarni in the organization; the MES Pune & Prof (Dr) Deshpande Director IMCC, Prof (Dr) Mrs Meenal Oak is the coordinator of the program.

For this programme, the candidates registering from all over the Maharashtra from *Mumbai*, *Bhusawal, Aurangabad, Shengaon, Nashik, Ahamadnagar, Mangaon , Solapur , Bhusawal* and Pune and various places nearby Pune as *Manchar, Baramati, Khed* etc.

The sessions were conducted by eminent personalities from Karnataka and Maharashtra states from India, as well as the foreign countries like the USA and Bangladesh.

During the academic year 2023-24, total 10 candidates of MES IMCC's SET NET Workshop have qualified for the SET Conducted on 7th April 2024; total 60 candidates of the MES SET/NET Program have qualified the SET/NET in the last 10 years.




