Every year, since 2015, the centre organizes two SET/NET Training programmes for LIS professionals to provide guidance to the professionals. The programme has become very successful as candidates are registering not only from Pune but also from various other places of Maharashtra such as Mumbai, Aurangabad, Bhusawal, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Neral, Mangaon, Manchar and many more. The 4th batch was started from 6th August 2017. Further, the institutional Library has launched a Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation and Networking (PGDLIMAN); a one year post graduate autonomous programme focused on effective utilization of advanced technology such as digital library techniques, automation, programming and networking in the libraries and information centres. The library has successfully implemented the Library softwares such as SLIM21 version 3.4.0 and d-space as well as the Libre Office for rendering effective library functions and services. 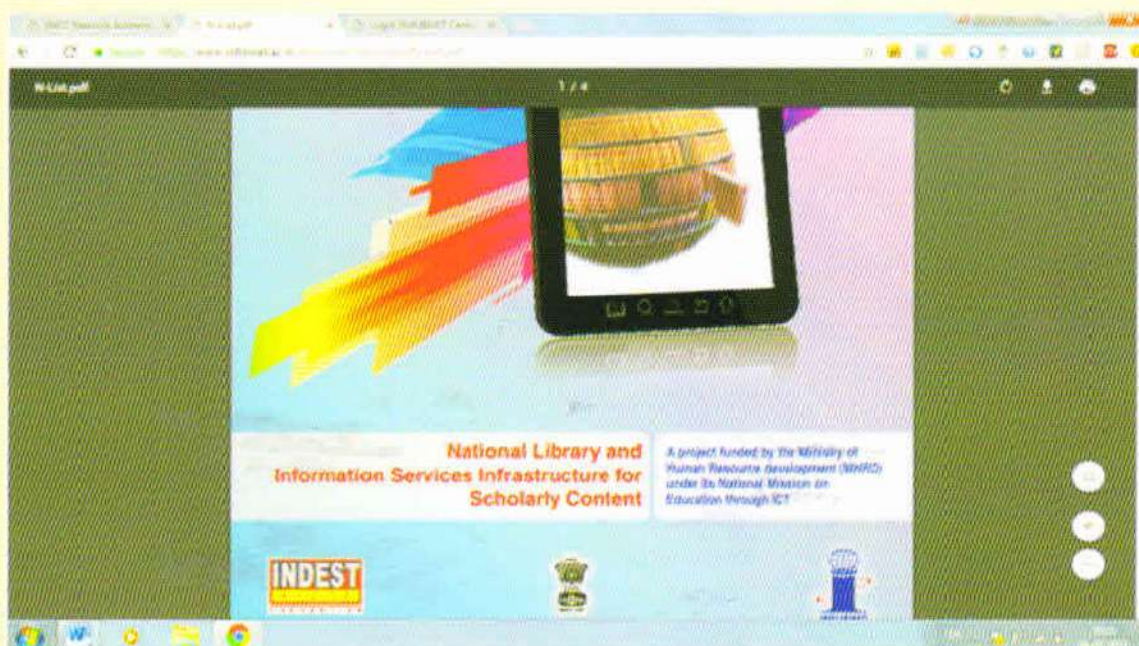
### E-resources

#### N-List database

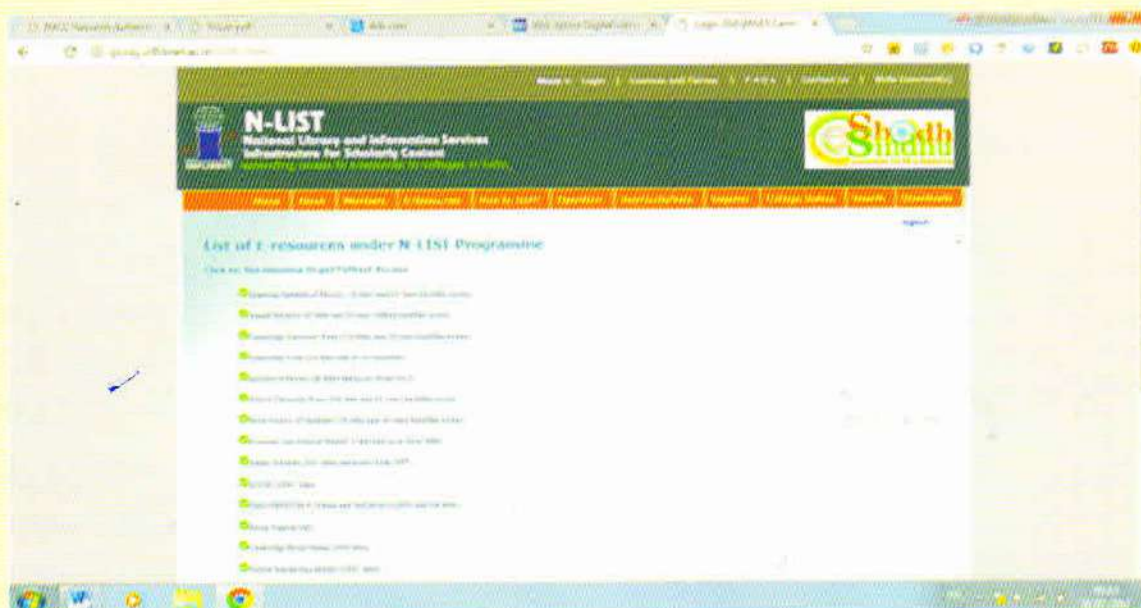
This year the library is successful in subscribing the N-List database under the 12B of UGC Act through the INFLIBNET. The passwords are created for the users and the training programme will be conducted for maximising use of the same. The library is doing continuous efforts to provide access to the variety of e-resources using paid subscriptions and also through the free access. During the year 2016-17, the library had given access to the N-list collection. At present through the N-List database the accessibility is provided to more than 6000 e-journals and 97,300 e-books.

The Project entitled "National Library and Information Services Infrastructure for Scholarly Content (N-LIST)", is being jointly executed by the UGC-INFONET Digital Library Consortium, INFLIBNET Centre and the INDEST-AICTE Consortium, IIT Delhi provides for i) cross-subscription to e-resources subscribed by the two Consortia, i.e. subscription to INDEST-AICTE resources for universities and UGC INFONET resources for technical institutions; and ii) access to selected e-resources to colleges. The N-LIST project provides access to e-resources to students, researchers and faculty from colleges and other beneficiary institutions through server(s) installed at the INFLIBNET Centre. The authorized users from colleges can now access e-resources and download articles required by them directly from the publisher's website once they are duly authenticated as authorized users through servers deployed at the INFLIBNET Centre.

As on July 26, 2017, a total number of 2957 Govt. / Govt.-aided colleges have been covered under the section 12B of UGC Act as well as Non-Aided colleges. Log-in ID and password for accessing e-resources has been sent to the authorized users from these 2957 colleges. All e-resources subscribed for colleges under the N-LIST Project are now accessible to these 2957 colleges through the N-LIST website (<http://nlist.inflibnet.ac.in>). As MES IMCC is covered under the section 12B of UGC Act the INFLIBNET has provided access to N-LIST database through the Log-in ID and Password in the year 2016-17.

## Digital Library Section:

The library has developed a digital library section for the entire user community, especially the student segment. The digital library section provides access to the online databases and Digital Institutional repository of the IMCC which consists of accessibility of the Summer Projects in e-format, question papers, syllabi, preprints of the research papers etc. It has now focused on building up the photo collection of the organization. **Improved Circulation services:****• Borrowing Services with improved Hardware Infrastructure:**

The library is now offering the document transactions from two separate counters at a time to provide the borrowing services more efficiently. Provision of the added equipments for the same such as computer, scanners has been done.

**• Generation of PVC Identity Cards:**

The library is now preparing Identity cards by using the Zebra printer ZXP 32 printer. The high quality PVC cards are prepared by using the ID preparation software.

**• Processing Unit:**

The library has created a separate section for processing the Identity cards and the borrower's tickets for the students and the faculty members as well. A separate section is created to process the Identity cards and the borrower's tickets during the year 2016-17.

**• Rearrangement of the Library Collection:**

The collection of the entire printed/non print information resources available in the library is basically divided into 5 sections -

- o Circulation collection (Books)
- o Hall Reading collection (Books)
- o Reference collection
- o Periodicals
- o Project reports & thesis collection
- o CD Collection

During the academic year 2016-17, the entire collection of the books is rearranged by redesigning the shelving plan. The collection is rearranged to accommodate the newer subjects and the books purchased and to create more ease of use to the library users. Accordingly the guide boards have been reworked and mounted.

**LIBRARY ACTIVITIES**

The basic purpose of this activity is to raise the awareness level of the newly entrant students regarding the library services, resources and the library rules and regulations, library staff for maximizing the usage of library. Library Orientation for freshers was conducted during the academic year 2016-17.

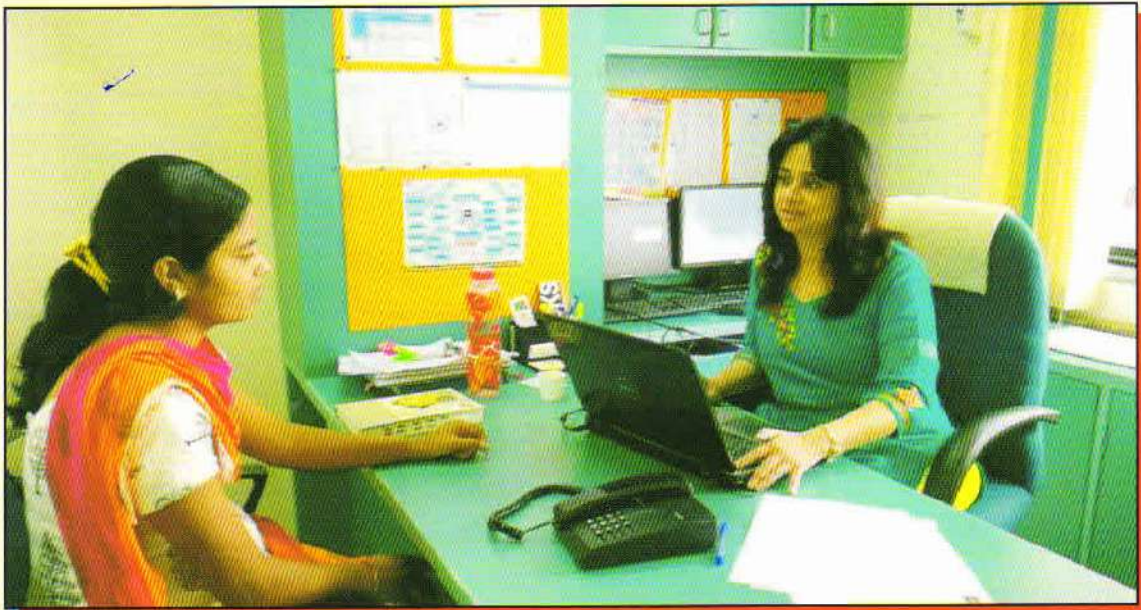
The library staff provides guidance to locate reading material and also to locate proper information from the library collection which helps the users in quick retrieval of the documents.

**Library Kit**

Every year Library distributes the "Library Kit" to the newly entrant students consisting of manuals of Library Facilities and Services, Library Rules, along with current year Borrowers Tickets. It facilitates users to get acquainted with the library environment.

### Training to LIS professionals in MES Institutions

IMCC has conducted 15 days advanced training program on Library service and functions, ICT in library for the library professionals of MES College of Nursing, Institute of Health Sciences , Ghanekhunt-Lote. Miss Rohita Patil, Assistant Librarian was deputed to attend the same in MES IMCC by MES College of Nursing, Institute of Health Sciences , Ghanekhunt-Lote which was well appreciated by the management and the attendees as well.

### BEST PRACTICES

The library has focused Benchmarking Technique followed by Continuous Improvement Principle. It has adopted innovative library services which are the best. The Libraries are coping up with the present scenario.

#### **Continuous Assessment :**

The Library has focused on continuous assessment of the library services by using the LIBQUAL+ technique. The users' responses are regularly collected and the feedback analysis is done every year for the past 7 years by using the questionnaire technique as well as through informal discussions and observation techniques.

Efforts have been made to implement the suggestions for the user segments.

#### **Effective use of ICT:**

The way of accessibility to information and changing user expectations due to ICT has a tremendous impact on the libraries. IMCC Library is continuously adopting newer ways to cope up with the changing scenario and particularly the extended and ever changing expectations of the tech-savvy users of computer and management science. The Library is rendering presently the services through the effective use of technology such as rendering services through the digital institutional repository, on-line accessibility of the databases on the campus, research orientation, plagiarism testing, computerised SDI, internet search for entire 12 hours on the working days of the institution.

### Antiplagiarism Policy :

Savitribai Phule Pune University has adopted anti-plagiarism policy to detect instances of plagiarism and thereby prevent the students from publishing, presenting and copying others' research work as their own. The University has adopted this policy as a part of quality research activity.

All the Ph.D. students are therefore required to attach original report of the Turnitin Software before submission of the Thesis to the Admission Section. The report is now one of the important requirements for initiating the further assessment procedure.

The Ph. D. research Centre of MES IMCC is equipped with the required software "turnitin", and the IMCC Library is playing a vital role in quality testing and originality using the turnitin software to the research scholars of MES IMCC through the report of originality.

### Library Ph.D. Research Centre :

The library has developed a separate section for Ph.D. research scholars for pursuing their research and study on the campus of IMCC. The library has built up an excellent collection of books and journals on finance, marketing, human resource and system management. The library provides a separate accessibility cell to the research scholars to access the e-resources. It provides accessibility to N-list and ASPP (IEEE) on-line databases for effective accessibility of the e-resources on varied subjects under Management Science. It also generates the originality reports using the "Turnitin" on-line software.

DR. ## MES IMCC'S PROGRAMMES FOR LIS PROFESSIONALS

The library staff took lead in the same and MES IMCC launched 2 programmes namely SET/NET Training Programme and Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN) an autonomous post graduate programme for the LIS professionals particularly in the Maharashtra state.

### SET/NET Training Programme

IMCC started the SET/NET training programme from the year 2015. The 4th batch of the SET NET training programme got started from 6th August 2017. The basic objective of the programme is to provide proper guidance to the fellow library professionals, in order to prepare them for the SET/NET Examination by the systematic conduction of the theory and MCQ's sessions. Enthusiasm and quest for knowledge of earlier batches has encouraged us to continue with our efforts of providing training for SET/NET examinations for the benefit of the library science professionals. The candidates are registering not only from Pune but also from all over Maharashtra such as Mumbai, Bhusawal, Aurangabad, Shengaon, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Mangaon, Solapur, Bhusawal and various places near Pune such as Manchar, Baramati, Khed etc. As on today total 10 candidates qualified the SET/NET examination.

The programme is designed and coordinated by DR. Mrs. Meenal Oak.

## **PGDLIMAN**

IMCC has launched the Post Graduate Diploma in Digital Library Management, Automation & Networking (PGDLIMAN) since September 2017. It is an autonomous programme of MES IMCC. It aims at developing the professional competencies of the library and information professionals in an automated and digital library network environment.

The programme focuses on in-depth practical sessions for building the technological skills of the students supported by required sessions on the theory, in order to develop them as an independent library manager who will manage the library in the new era successfully. The Libraries today are impacted tremendously by the digital and networked environment. ICT has a major impact on the

storage functions and delivery of information in the library. The task ahead is a major challenge to handle the voluminous data in the digitized form and to manage it successfully for serving the user segments in an effective manner.

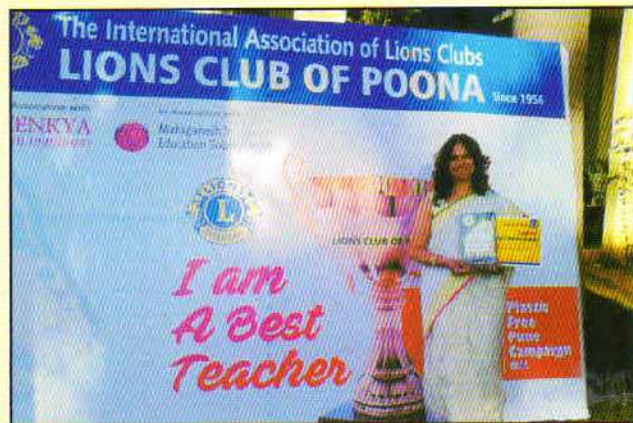
The objectives of the programme are to imbibe the knowledge of the basic requirements of library automation and automated library services with the major focus on Open Source Library Software systems such as D-space and KOHA; to provide the knowledge and skills on networking and Internet technology in particular to the library and information networks; to develop the Internet skills with special focus on the information resources available in different forms and subjects; to provide the knowledge and skills of web designing and the legal issues associated with electronic information; to enable the design and development of a programme by enhancing skills on programming based on the language C++; to undertake a practical based project in order to specialize in one of the thrust areas on library automation and networking.

The Programme is of high benefit to the qualified Librarians and all other working library professionals as well as the budding LIS candidates interested in upgrading the ICT Knowledge, skills and its effective application in the current automated and networked library environment. The programme is open to candidates with a minimum Bachelor's Degree in Library and Information Science (BLISc).

Dr Mrs Meenal Oak is the Coordinator of the programme.

She has completed 2 minor research projects sponsored by savitribai Phule Pune University during 2012-14, & 2014-16 respectively and also an associate editor of the Research India Publication Journals of Library Science, and the International Journal of Innovative Knowledge Concepts. She has conducted the sessions on Plagiarism, effective accessibility of on-line resources, Benchmarking and service quality, Literature Review and utilization of on-line resources like N-List, ASPP etc. in the reputed academic institutions like Fergusson College, Sinhadgad Institutions, MIT Group of Colleges and many other Arts, Science and Commerce Colleges, Management Institutions, Professional Bodies of Architectures like NYASA under the jurisdiction of Savitribai Phule Pune University as well as in Shivaji University and also in the corporate industries like Tata Motors.

### IGNOU STUDY CENTRE

DR. Mrs. Meenal Oak, Librarian, IMCC took the charge of IGNOU Study Centre -16142 from January 2015 as a Study Centre Coordinator. The system and the entire administrative procedures of the Study Centre 16142 of IGNOU are streamlined and regularised as per the norm of the IGNOU, New Delhi. The Study Centre 16142 of IGNOU forms an important part of overall structure of the University designed to provide extensive and efficient student support services to its learners. The Study Centre is established to offer students a 'Kit of communication channels to supplement contents of the course in the form of print material mailed to them and enable them to interact with academic counselors and fellow students as also to provide access to modern technology through the use of audio-visual aids. Thus, the Study Centre seeks to help the students in independent learning by means of appropriate forms of educational technologies.

The study centre IGNOU 16142 is equipped with relevant course material, reference books, audio-visual aids integrated with the course material. The Study Centre arranges to extend these facilities to all the learners attached to it on specific days decided by the Coordinator. The required assistance is provided to the students by the Study Centre so as to help them take the maximum benefit of these facilities. Regular week-end counselling takes place at the Study Centre along with the hands on practical exposure provided to the learner at the practical centres.

DR. Uma Kanjilal a Professor of Library and Information Science and Director I/C of Advanced Centre of Informatics and Innovative Learning (ACIIL) at Indira Gandhi National Open University, New Delhi and DR. Archana Shukla an Assistant Professor (Sr. Scale) in the Faculty of Library and Information Science visited MES IMCC's IGNOU Study Centre 16142 for interacting with the Coordinator of the study centre and with the LIS students. During the visit, the journey of MES IMCC's IGNOU Study Center 16142, Pune was presented.
