- **User Orientation Program**

- **Librarians Day**

The birth anniversary of Padmashri Prof. (Dr.) S. R. Ranganathan, the founder of library science in India, an honorary member of the International Federation of Information and Documentation (FID) from 1957, the lifetime vice-president of the Library Association of Great Britain in London, is celebrated across the country as Librarian Day.

He was also a professor at Delhi University (1947-55), where higher education in library science was introduced for the first time in India, and served as the librarian and professor of library science at Banaras Hindu University (1945-47).

The five fundamental rules of library science (1931), which have received global recognition, are still implemented today as standards, more than 80 years later, and these rules are seen as the foundational principles of modern library management. The Indian-origin two-pointer classification system, classified cataloguing, principles and examples of reference services, and chain directing in cataloguing are significant contributions to library and information science. Dr. Ranganathan's early service as a university librarian at the University of Madras and the emergence of the two-pointer and fundamental rules from it marked an important journey towards making library science a subject of study! Awarded the Padmashri by the Government of India in 1957, he was a global thinker who provided direction to all aspects of library and information science!

- **Continuous service upgradation**



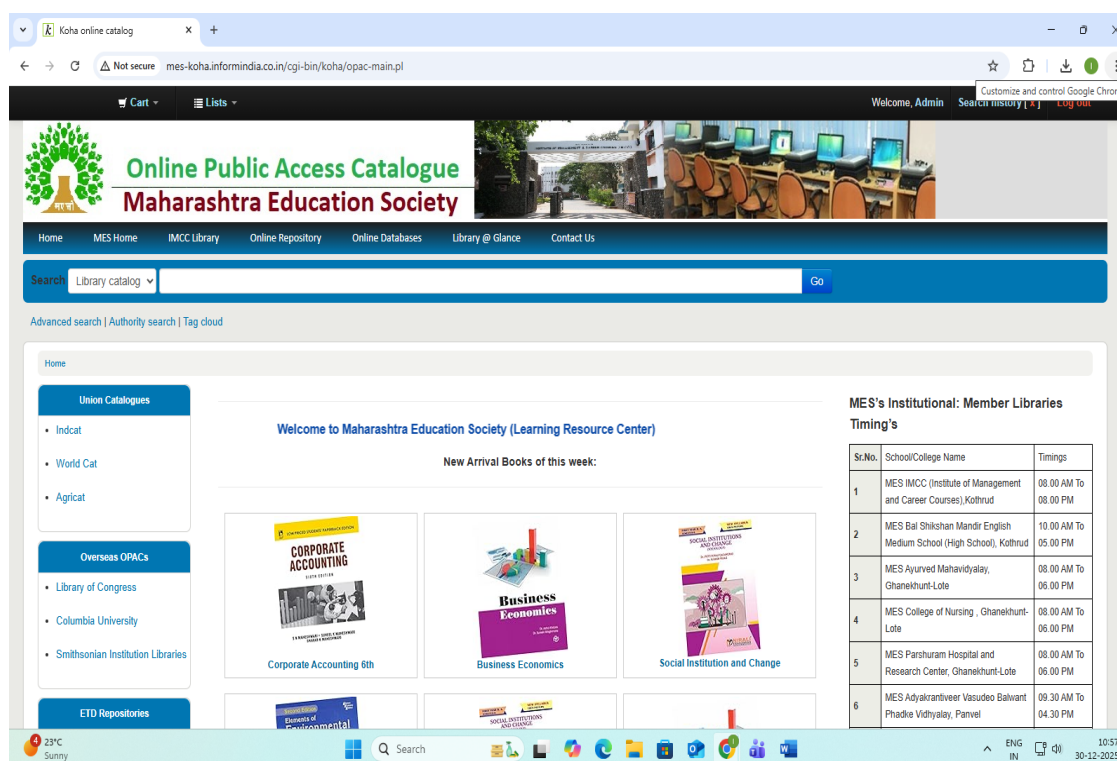

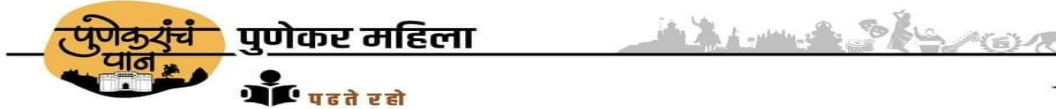

वाचन आणि बरेच काही...

सामान्यतः वाचन हा कोणत्याही शिक्षण संस्कृतीचा एक अविभाज्य आणि महत्त्वपूर्ण घटक आहे हे सर्वत्रून आहे. वाचन ही यशाची गुरुकिल्ली आहे, असं म्हटलं तर वाचन ठरगार नाही. 'वाचन' हा शब्द मूळ संस्कृतमधील 'वच' ह्या धातूपासून बनलेला आहे, तर 'वच' ह्याच अर्थ बोलणे आणि 'वाच' म्हणजे बोलण्यास लावणारे, म्हणजेच वाचन केल्यावरच वाणी सक्षम होईल. वाचन ही एक कला आहे, असे मानले जाते. आपल्याकडे ज्या चौसष्ट कला मानल्या गेल्या आहेत, त्यापैकी एक म्हणजे वाचन कला! ते एक कोशलय आहे. संपूर्ण एकतेने वाचणारे आणि वाचलेले अतिरिक्त सहजगत्या लक्षात ठेवणारे महान तत्त्वज्ञ आणि भारताचे आदर्शस्थान स्वामी विवेकानंद तसेच भारताचे राष्ट्रपती अब्दुल कलाम ह्यांचे ग्रंथीय त्यांच्या 'द व्हॅनरगुल व्हर्डे ऑफ बुक्स' या ग्रंथामधून दिसते. विल मॅथर यांच्या जीवनावर योग्यांच्या तऱ्हेने परिणाम करणाऱ्या ग्रंथाचा त्यांनी आखडून केलेला उल्लेख, जीवनाचे सार सांगून जातो.

वाचन कशासाठी ?
काही वक्तू अभावानेच जीवनाचे सार सांगतांना दिसतात की, पुस्तके वाचून काही होत नाही (सामान्यपणे वाचन हा कार्यसिद्धीचा अविभाज्य भाग आहे, असे प्रमुख वक्तू सांगतात). वस्तुतः ते, पुस्तके वाचून काही होत नाही, असा आश्वासन भरलेले असते. याचे कारण म्हणजे बदरला रोण्यासाठी ज्ञानाला कार्याची जोड मिळणे आवश्यक असते; पण त्या आधी ज्ञानाने मनाचे संस्करण होणे आवश्यक! आणि ज्ञान हे अनुभवजन्य असलेच, त्याबरोबरच ते विचारणाऱ्या संस्कारांनी सिद्ध असत तर काय चांगल्यास्तरावर आणायची शक्यता अधिकरतीने वाढते.

वाचनाची प्रमुख कारणे
१) व्यक्तिमत्त्व विकास
२) सुसंस्कारित वाणी
३) आनंदबोध

अभ्यासात्मक चिंतन
ज्ञान आत्मसात करण्याकरिता केल्या जाणाऱ्या साधनेला, सामान्य भाषेतल्या आपण ज्याला 'अभ्यास' असे म्हणतो, त्याच्या पाठ्या अनुक्रमे वाचन, मनन, चिंतन, लेखन आणि त्यानंतर होतं ते... आकलन ह्या आहेत. सर्वत महिली पाहारी अर्थात 'वाचने' - हा ज्ञानाचा मूळ स्रोत आहे. ज्यामुळे व्यक्तीच्या आत्मनिष्ठ व्यक्तिमत्त्वाचा विकास होतो.
आजच्या काळातील सर्व प्रकारची वाचन / माहिती साधने एकत्रितपणे जतन आणि संवर्धन करण्याची जागा म्हणजे ग्रंथालय! भारतीय शिक्षण क्षेत्राबरोबरच



भारतीय ग्रंथालयीन परंपरासुद्धा थोर आहे; तबलीला विद्यापीठाचे प्राचीन ग्रंथालय हे उदाहरण आहे.
या ग्रंथालयीन इतिहासामध्ये अनेक चिनी आणि ग्रीक प्रवाशांनी ग्रंथालयाना भेट दिल्याच्या नोंदी सापडतात. प्राचीन काळाच्या राजेशाही वास्तवशास्त्रापासूनच भारतामध्ये अनेक विषयांचा अभ्यास होत आहे. असे वैदिक गणित, स्वामय्य आणि आयुर्वेदशास्त्र, खगोलशास्त्र, त्यानगणेश ज्योतिष आणि आयुर्वेदशास्त्र, यज्ञ आणि नौकानयन असे विविध विषय त्या काळी अभ्यासलेले आढळतात. प्राचीन काळातील ग्रंथालये ही राजकार, भक्ति आणि शिक्षण संस्थांमधून जतन केली जात असत. त्यानंतर ब्रिटिश राजवटीच्या काळात पश्चिमाटिक सोसायटीचे ग्रंथालय (१७८६), कलकत्ता पब्लिक ग्रंथालय (१८३७), पश्चिमाटिक सोसायटी ऑफ ग्रेट ब्रिटन व आयर्लंड (१८२७) अशी प्राचीन काळातील भारतीय ग्रंथालयीन वादवात आढळते. त्यानंतर आधुनिक काळातील विज्ञान आणि संशोधन, माहिती प्रसार आणि देवधेय यांच्या वाढीमुळे छापील ज्ञान साधनांबरोबरच माहिती इलेक्ट्रॉनिक संस्कृतामध्ये प्रारंभ होऊ लागला. वादवात माहितीदुःख माहिती, ई-पुस्तके आणि ई-माहितीच्या स्वरूपात प्रकाशित होऊ लागली. ह्या डिजिटल माहिती स्रोतांमुळे माहितीची प्रतिप्राप्ती कमीत कमी वेळात साध्य झाली.
वाचन स्रोत वाढले आणि ग्रंथालये अधिक समृद्ध बनली. त्याबरोबरच वाचन स्रोत मिळवण्याकरिता आज पर्यसल्या अनेकविध पर्याय निर्माण झाले (ज्यांमध्ये स्वयं ई-लनिंगमुळे पारंपरिक क्लासरूम शिक्षणस व्यवय आले), ग्रंथालयावर किंसेल्ट राहण्याची आवश्यकता वाचकांना कमी प्रमाणातच जाणवू

लागली. असे जरी असले तरी वाचनाचे महत्त्व आजही तेवढेच अबाधित आहे.
वाचन कसे असावे, काय वाचावे ?
वाचन हे चौफेर असावे हे तर खरेच! त्यासाठी सांगणाना व्यासंग, एकाग्र बुद्धी आणि सर्वात महत्त्वाचे म्हणजे वाचनाची आतर्निग होणे हे नितात गरजेचे! महाराष्ट्र राज्य शासनाने त्यासाठी प्रशिक्षण वर्गांचीही आता योजना केली आहे.
बहुशून्य व्यक्तिमत्त्व घडविण्यासाठी सर्व प्रकारचे वाचन असे अतर्निग, विषयगुरु, तौलनिक, लौकालिक, विविध लेखन शैलींमधून अशा स्वरूपाचे वाचन अत्यवश्यक असते; आणि ह्याचे संस्कार बालपणापासून ते पौढावस्थेपर्यंत केल्यास एक परिष्कृत व्यक्तिमत्त्व उदयास येते. काय खावे ह्याला जसे तौलनिक आणि योग्य आहार असे उतर पडता आहारविषयक तज्ञां देईल, त्यानुसारच बुद्धिला पालना देणारे आणि उद्दिष्टपूर्तीकडे नेणारे वाढाई ग्रंथ वाचवत, असे एक ग्रंथपाला सांगेल. समग्र समयास स्वामीनी, साधना करताना कोणते ग्रंथ वाचावेत आणि कसे वाचन करावे, हे सुद्धा 'दाससोधा' मध्ये यत्नपूर्वपणे सांगितले आहे.
'आत्मज्ञानी येकचित्तः तेषो पाहावे अद्वैत. येकत स्वकीं निवातं समाधान ॥'
