User Orientation Program

Every year, MES IMCC's KRC conducts an orientation program for the freshers of MBA and MCA programs to make them aware of the KRC features. Database Awareness Program for the Students

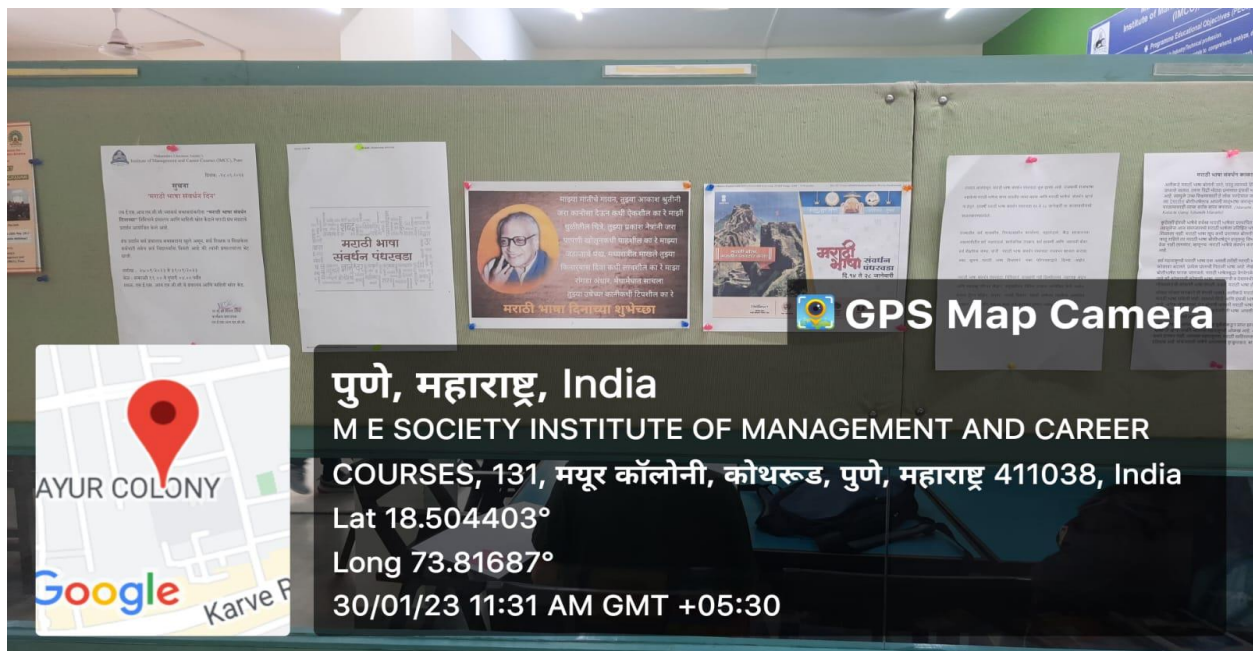

Application of LibQual + and SIX sigma @ the KRC

The knowledge resource center of IMCC is consistently applying the service quality assessment in a cyclic manner as a way to raise the standard of the provided service. In addition, the open-ended feedback from the outgoing students and users from other segments is also taken and displayed on the library boards.

The KRC also applied the SIX sigma technique to eliminate and streamline the processes to raise the effectiveness of the library performance; from the last 4 years, the six-sigma technique is applied for the more effective performance for the information service delivery.

Library @ your doorstep:

The KRC is providing the SDI to the faculty members and the research scholars with the core concept of reaching the users at the door step through the e-mode library service through the online SDI through the variety of databases such as World e-books database through the DELNET National Consortium, ProQuest database, N-list and kopykitab.


Effective Accessibility to the electronic information resources through the KRC webpage:

The KRC webpage has been continuously upgraded on the institutional website to provide access to e-books and e-journals through the paid and open-source online databases.

The webpage provides effective access to the N-List, World e-book database & ProQuest, as well as DELNET through the Institutional Static IPs on the campus along with the provision of online membership to the students, faculty members, and research scholars. Access to the UNIMARC catalog through the MES koha OPAC facilitates the user segments to get the status of the KRC documents and about the new arrivals. The KRC Digital IR through the webpage remotely assists in e-projects accessibility to the students.


IMCC KRC Web OPAC: -

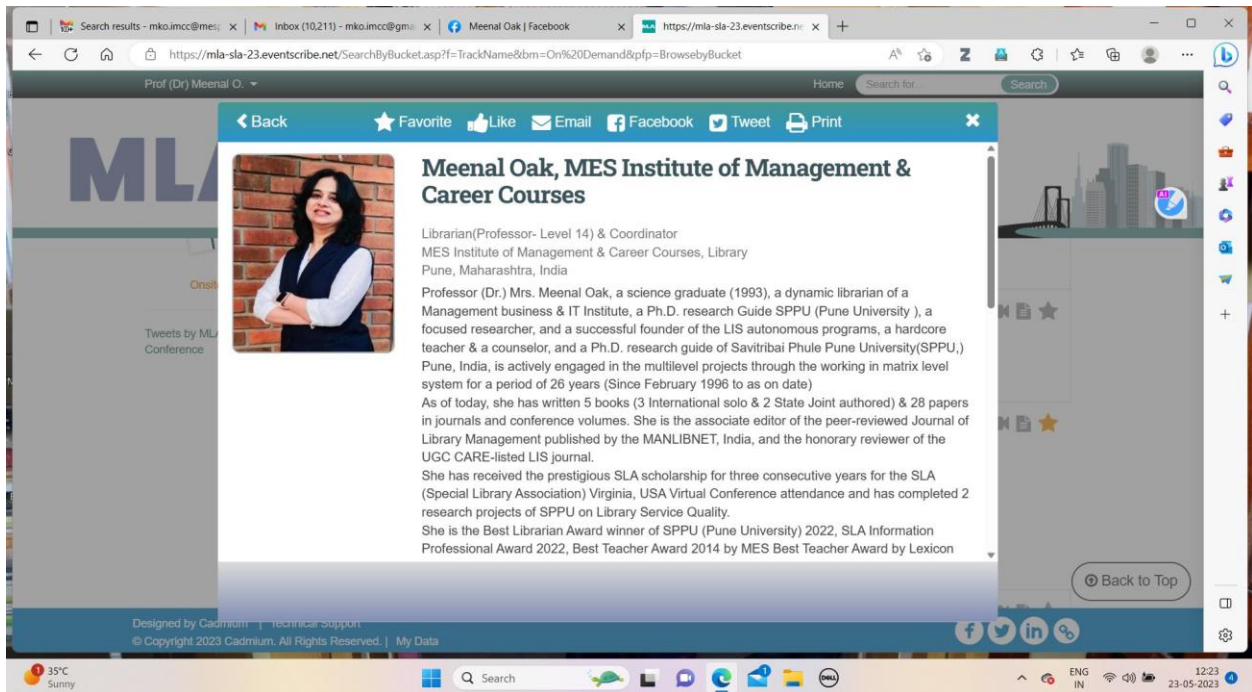

This program is a boon to the qualified LIS professionals working in the colleges and academic institutions in the state for effectively applying the ICT in the libraries and

Information centers. The 3rd batch of PGDLIMAN for the A Y 2022-23 started on 9th October 2022, the candidates registered from Pune, Mumbai, Amravati, Ahmednagar, and Satara. The program uses hybrid media for the session, assignment evaluation, and examination conduction. The primary medium is Google Classroom followed by Zoom and offline sessions.

Every year MES IMCC conducts the 2 batches of the SET/NET Training programme for the budding LIS professionals in society. The basic aim is to provide proper guidance to fellow library professionals, to prepare them for the SET/NET Examination by the *systematic conduction* of the theory and MCQ's sessions from the year 2015. The basic attitude of MES for grooming the learners and enthusiasm and quest for knowledge of earlier batches have encouraged us to continue with our efforts of providing training for SET/NET examinations for the benefit of the library science profession. For this programme, the candidates registering from all over Maharashtra from *Mumbai, Bhusawal,*

Aurangabad, Shengaon, Nashik, Ahmednagar, Mangaon, Solapur and Pune, and various places nearby Pune as Manchar, Baramati, Khed etc.

The sessions were conducted by eminent personalities from Karnataka and Maharashtra states from India, as well as foreign countries like the USA and Bangladesh.

During the academic year 2022-23, the MES has conducted the 11th & 12th SET/NET Workshop through a virtual mode. As of date, a total of 49 qualified attempts have been made by the candidates from the 12 consecutive batches.

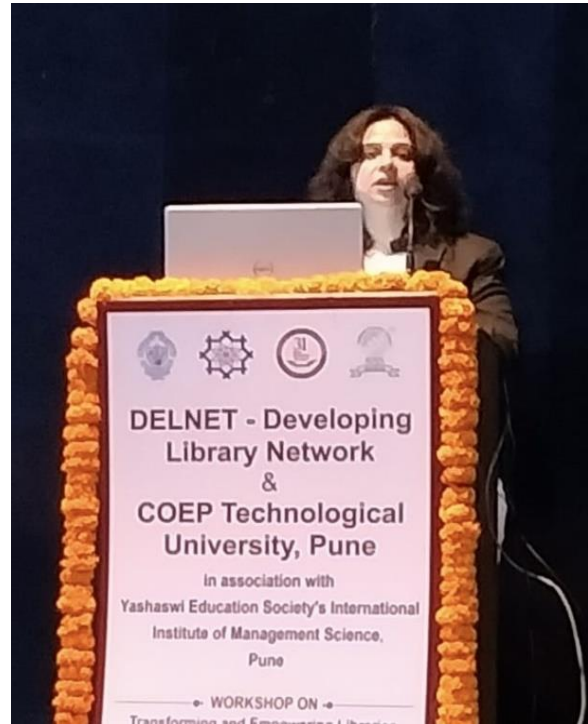
